**The Sunday Mass Collection** is the principle means of financial support of the Cathedral parish. The Cathedral including the Good Samaritan Program operate on a combined budget of one million dollars. The Sunday Collection for the fiscal year ending in June, 2016 was \$477,224.02. Other donations amounted to \$126,694.54. This includes donations for weddings, baptisms, flowers, candles, coffee hour and more. The subsidy from the diocese is \$60,000.00. In October I made the appeal for an increased offertory. My hope is to increase the Sunday Collection by one hundred thousand dollars or two thousand dollars per week. I am happy to report the collection has increased and we are well on the way to reaching our new goal. Each week the previous week's collection is reported in the bulletin. The overall weekly goal is \$11,000.00 which is roughly divided between the two Masses in Spanish at a goal of \$2,400.00 and the four Masses in English at a goal of \$8,600.00.
